



CARROT HYBRID KXPC-081

An Early Nantes Variety

KXPC-081 is an early Nantes type carrot that produces strong and vigorous tops that are about 16 to 19 inches tall. Foliage attachment in this variety is very strong. The roots are about 7 to 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches long and well filled to the tip being almost cylindrical, and about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches in diameter. No green shoulders.

The exterior and interior color is dark orange and the roots are very smooth. KXPC-081 has shown good tolerance to *Alternaria dauci* and *Cercospora carotae* under field conditions. Also, it has shown resistance to *Powdery mildew* in various geographical locations.

This variety is tolerant to premature bolting and has great flavor.

Markets: Bunching, cello-pack and slicing in Europe, fresh markets in Asia, Central and South America, Canada and South Africa.
